Sanitizer station to be provided at outdoor sessions provided by Euxton Girls with indoor facilities to stay out of use pending further advice.</p> <p>Also reminded to catch coughs and sneezes in tissues – Follow Catch it, Bin it, kill it and to avoid touching face, eyes, nose or mouth with unclean hands. All parents \ coaches to let coaches know if anyone has any of the above and to stay home. Tissues will be made available at any fixed site at the cleaning station.
